1. What this policy covers

This Cookie Policy explains how we use cookies and similar technologies (pixels, local storage, SDKs — collectively, "cookies") on the Platform.

2. What cookies are

A cookie is a small text file placed on your device when you visit a website. Cookies allow the site to recognise your device and store certain information about your preferences or actions. Some are deleted when you close your browser ("session cookies"); others persist ("persistent cookies"). Cookies set by us are "first-party"; those set by other domains we integrate are "third-party".

3. Categories of cookies we use

Functional	Remember your preferences (language, theme)	Yes
Analytics / performance	Measure how visitors use the site and help us fix bugs	Yes
Marketing	Personalised advertising (currently not used on the Platform)	Yes

5. Consent — how to give, refuse, and withdraw

The first time you visit the Platform, a cookie banner asks you to accept all, reject all, or set granular preferences. Strictly necessary cookies are always on. Accept and Reject buttons are presented with equal prominence, consistent with the EDPB Cookie Banner Taskforce Report adopted 18 January 2023 (which found that the absence of an option to refuse cookies at the same level of prominence as the option to accept constitutes a breach of the legislation) and with the CJEU's Planet49 ruling (C-673/17).

We do not use pre-ticked boxes. We log your consent. You may change your choices at any time by clicking the "Cookie settings" link in our footer.

In California, our "Cookie settings" link also serves as the link to limit sale/sharing (we do not currently sell or share, but the control is provided per the CCPA).

6. Your browser controls

Most browsers let you delete cookies or block them. Note that blocking strictly necessary cookies may prevent the Platform from functioning. For Global Privacy Control (GPC) signals, we honour an opt-out where required by law.

7. Third-party cookies

Where third parties set cookies via the Platform, you should also consult their own policies (e.g., Google: policies.google.com/technologies/cookies). We act as joint controller for the setting of such cookies on our pages and rely on your consent.

8. Updates

We may update this Cookie Policy. The effective date at the top will change accordingly. Material changes will be notified via the Platform.
